Boating safety:

The weekend will be a complete success if we can create an environment where students can have the most amount of fun, without injuring themselves or others. As such, we have a few common sense rules that each student needs to internalize:

1. Be aware of your surroundings while you are in the water and while you are in the boats.
2. Help the driver maintain a safe environment by listening to him whenever he speaks. He'll either be asking you to help him do something, or he'll be instructing a skier in the water.
3. When you are in a boat, look for stuff in the water that the boat might run over: ski ropes, debris, swimmers, etc.
4. If you want to get into a boat, never swim up to it. Always wait for the boat to stop at the houseboat or on the shore.
5. Stay seated whenever the boat is running. Please don't sit on the gunnels (sides of the boat). Always sit in the seats. California boating law mandates a **\$1200** fine for each person sitting on the gunnels. Yeow! One of those tickets will really increase the cost of your fun-filled weekend!
6. Feet First!! No diving head first into the water, especially by the shore, unless you have a boat driver's permission.
7. Swimmers must NEVER be in the sport boats' loading and unloading zone. This is the area on either side of the houseboat and behind it.
